'Goa Mankurad' also known as Mankurad, Malcorada, Cardozo Mankurad, Corado, Goa Mankur, etc., is the most popular variety that is available throughout Goa. Mankurad Mango is very much loved in Goa for its consistently glowing golden colour, attractive yellow exteriors, and intense aroma full of flavours and very fleshy. Goa Mankurad is the most popular commercial variety of Goa and popular throughout the State and neighbouring ones and preferred over all other known unknown varieties grown in the State as a table fruit.

Uniqueness

- The Goa Mankurad Mango is a prominent fruit crop in Goa, representing one of over 80 traditional mango varieties in the state. It grows well in lateritic, alluvial, sandy loam. It is well adapted to the subtropical climate of Goa. The high total soluble solids(TSS) translates into exceptional sweetness, making it highly desirable for consumption as a table fruit. Beyond fresh consumption, Goa Mankurad Mangoes are versatile for value-added products such as pickles, jams, cakes, toffees, and lassi.

Method of Production

Due to Goa's highly favourable climate for mango cultivation, the entire state predominantly undertakes mango plantation through vegetative propagation. This method ensures consistency, maintains parental quality, promotes early fruiting, and enhances productivity in the offspring. In grafting, shoots (scions) are grafted onto seedlings known as rootstock, which provide the necessary root system.
