### Method of Production

The procedure begins with creating a paper pulp mixture combined with copper sulphate & rice flour. This mixture is molded into various shapes & are allowed to dry. Once dry, the designs are intricately sketched on the surface & the products are lacquered & polished in bright vibrant colors often with a touch of gold for added details.
